The curriculum for the qualification of the International Arab Certified Public accountant (IASCA) has been developed to comply with the international curriculum issued by the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD) in collaboration with a group of consultants from IASCA, Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA), Certified General Accountants Association in Canada (CGA-Canada), European Commission, the Federation International des Experts Compatibles Francophone (FIDEF), the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Scotland (ICAS), the Polish Accounting Standards Board and the International Federation of Accountants (IFAC), as well as representatives of academic and international accounting firms acting in their personal competence.

Arab Recognition of IACPA Certification

The international Arab Certified Public Accountant (IACPA) Certificate, issued by the International Arab Society of Certified Accountants (IASCA), has been accredited and recognized in many Arab countries, such as the United Arab Emirates (UAE), Palestine, Yemen, and Syria, Kurdistan region (Iraq), Oman and Libya in addition to, Lebanon, Sudan and Qatar. It has also been recognized by the Hashemite kingdom of Jordan, the domicile country, through a decision by the High Council of Accounting and Auditing to include IASCA in the list of professional association of the certified accountant.
